

Add to that a secret garden full of winding paths and surprising statues in hidden corners, a rowing boat and SUP boards and you have the perfect location for a romantic escape for two. NEW SPA GARDEN

From spring 2020, guests at Chapel House boutique hotel in Penzance can enjoy the newly opened spa garden, which has been kitted out with a sauna for six, an outdoor shower, and a hot tub with bird's eye views across the harbour to the iconic Cornish landmark St Michael's Mount. On a summer's evening there's no better place to look up at the clear West Cornwall skies towards the Milky Way. The sheltered plot originally served as Chapel House's kitchen garden, and owner Susan Stuart has been busy replanting and restoring it to its former glory. With a bounty of fruit trees, and vines and wisteria trailing across the trellis, the garden is a beautiful place to relax in after a day out exploring. VIEWS OF THE SEA

Located above little-known Lundy Bay near Polzeath, Little T is ideal for family downtime. Accessed via a private driveway and surrounded by open countryside, it has uninterrupted views down to the sea and is the perfect base for wild swimming and picnics on the beach. The South West Coast Path is close by too, providing rambles north and south to escape the crowds. Cook dinner on the BBQ and gather around the fire-pit's crackling flames to gaze at the stars. Four bedrooms sleep eight people – drift off for a sound night's sleep and awaken to birdsong. From £4,795 per week, available from July (01208 869090, latitude50.co.uk).





BESIDE THE SEA
