The Coach House near Rock, Cornwall

This Grade II-listed, Georgian-style building can be found within a 40-acre private estate. Bordering the Camel Estuary, this home is the perfect romantic escape or a chance to get away with the kids. Part of the Dinham Estate, The Coach House was originally built in the 1630s as a summer retreat and hunting lodge and now boasts a newly refurbished kitchen, farmhouse table and a private sun terrace and garden. The abode is just moments from the best beaches in North Cornwall and surrounded by woodland, perfect for an early morning stroll.

Carn Mar on Polzeath Beach, Cornwall
