There's a nod to the nautical with porthole windows and splashes of blue, plus a sunny terrace and a barbecue. Sleeping four, it costs from £578 per week, original cottages.co.uk



The Pink Cottage Zennor With modern style behind its Grade II-listed granite walls, this cosy bolthole - with its rose-tinted gate, door and Aga - is surrounded by the rugged, boulder-strewn landscape of Zennor, just four miles from St Ives. Inside, it's full of nooks for books and logs for the burner, with handwoven cushions, original doors and rustic wooden tables. There's a lovely garden sleek bathroom with living plants, and two bedrooms including a twin room. Sleeping four, it costs from £595 for three nights, kiphideaways.com

Wenmouth Cottage Looe

Suited to couples and small families - plus up to two dogs - this 17th-century cottage is within walking distance of Looe harbour, plus shops, pubs, restaurants and the beach. Stone walls, wood beams and steep stairs add to the traditional feel, and children will love the large oak window seat in the bunk bedroom. The kitchen has an electric oven and hob, plus a washing nachine, while the private courtyard is just the spot for a sundowner. Sleeping four, it costs from £500 per week, holidaycottages.co.uk

Three Mile Beach Gwithian Opening in May, these 15 colourful beach houses - created by Audley Travel founder Craig Burkinshaw and his partner Joanne Le Bon - are scattered among the sand dunes behind Gwithian Beach. A hidden door swings back to reveal the king-size bed. Wheelbarrow your bags down the solar-lit track and pick vegetables from the garden. Cook up a feast on the induction hob, or on the Dutch oven over an open fire outside. Sleeping two, it costs from £120 per night,

Trevanion Cottage, Coverack Perfectly positioned to explore West Cornwall and the Lizard peninsula, this charming three-bedroom cottage in the fishing village of Coverack has been recently refurbished with elegant interiors, open-plan living spaces and a handy wet room on the ground floor.
